

Internet and Telephone Scams, Fraud, Security and Safety for Today's Family

While having lunch with a friend (who is a Trust Officer at a prominent Dallas Bank), I was alerted to a scam involving the elderly that is circulating in our area. This sad scenario is being repeated often and is devastating for both the victims and their families. Our discussion over lunch that day prompted me to investigate the possibility

of having a seminar/presentation to help all of us avoid scams and become more aware of security and safety precautions in our multi-technical world today. Whether you have elementary school children, teens, elderly parents, a business, or just enjoy the communication benefits of the Internet, this seminar will help guide you to safe and secure interactions for your family.

Plano Police Detective Jerry Minton and his partner Detective Kimberly Neal from the Fraud Investigation Division will provide an interactive presentation about the alarming numbers and types of crimes happening in our area (as well as nationwide) involving the Internet,



including social media, websites, telephone solicitation and mortgage scams. They will be discussing crimes using information available on the Internet, as well as specific Internet crime including e-mail, spam, facebook, websites, etc., along with telephone solicitations and scams involving banking, personal information and mortgages. Their focus will be on how to identify and protect yourself from these types of crimes including how to manage an incident should a crime involve you.

Our computer whisperer, **Phil Pollacia, an Instructor in Computer Science at the Plano Senior Center**, will discuss methods to ensure Internet safety for home computers, as well as recommended programs and their installation. In addition, Phil has generously offered (by appointment) to assist any FCWC members with security for their home computers.

This is truly an evening not to miss! Whether you have concerns for elderly or younger family members using the computer, you need to be aware of how to protect your personal information when using the Internet. The information shared this evening will provide peace of mind for our families. I very much appreciate all of our Professionals attending and sharing their expertise with FCWC.






