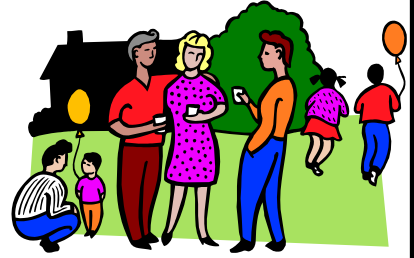

Antique Road Show January 14th

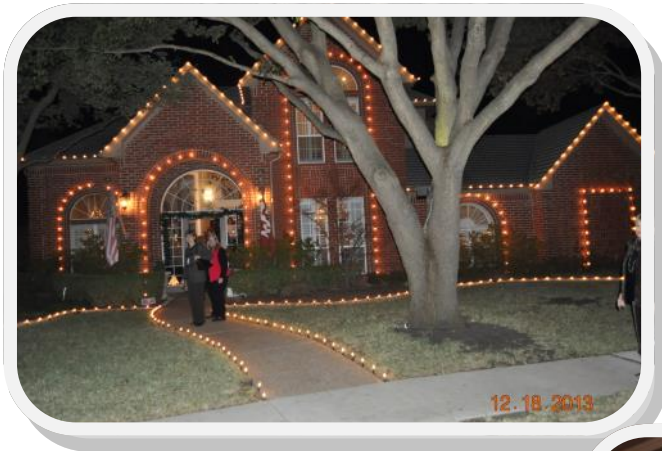
