

Service Project for FCWC- Fall, 2013


Coats for Kids is going to be our focus once again this fall. Bowman Middle School in East Plano will be the recipient of our service project. Many of the families at Bowman have limited resources, and according to counselors, many of their students go the entire winter without a coat. Our club will be donating coats for these children and their families. We will be collecting used coats, new coats and coats purchased at thrift stores or locally at double deep discounts. You are encouraged to participate in any way you would like, whether it be by donating used items, or perhaps giving a monetary donation. (Unfortunately we can't give you a tax receipt for your donation due to our club status, but we will tell you that these coats mean a child will not be cold!) Last year we were able to donate just under 100 coats and to say the school was beyond Thrilled is an understatement! Would love to break our record this year!

You can bring donations to meetings, or drop them off at my home (3436 Terry Drive). **Ideally we are looking for coats that could be considered warm and waterproof, with hoods, in any size from Infant through XXL.** If your donation doesn't match that criteria, no worries. The coat itself is the most important thing. When I purchase a coat, that is what I am looking for, however. And, if you are considering purchasing coats, just to let you know, I spend at most \$10 for a used garment, so your cash donation goes a very long way!




